## Society for Integrative Oncology Patient Advocate Scholarship Eligibility Criteria for Pre-Conference Workshop, “Sleeping Well After Cancer: Translating Patient-Centered Research Into Practice”

*Pre-Conference Workshop held October 19, 2019 as part of the SIO 16<sup>th</sup> International Conference, October 19-21, 2019 at the New York Hilton Midtown, New York, NY*

- Scholarship applications are open to oncology patient advocates in the United States. A **patient advocate** is defined as an individual who volunteers or works for pay with a local, state/provincial, national or international non-profit organization that provides programs, services, information, and support for people with cancer and their families and demonstrates a charitable mission, including a commitment to knowledge dissemination and translation.
- Applications must be at least one year out of primary cancer treatment.
- In addition, scholarship applicants must:
  - Be able to attend the SIO 16<sup>th</sup> International Conference and pre-conference workshop on October 19, 2019 (7:45 a.m. to 11:45 a.m. ET), and, preferably, the entire 16<sup>th</sup> International Conference (the conference begins at 1 p.m. ET on Saturday, October 19, 2019 and ends at 5 p.m. ET on Monday, October 21)
  - Belong to an advocacy organization or represent a constituency so information can be disseminated
  - Have an interest in the science of cancer as it relates to integrative care
  - Briefly state their expectations of the pre-conference workshop, including what they intend to gain, how it will enhance their advocacy role(s) and ability to serve people with cancer, and how they will share/disseminate what they learn about sleep management with their communities
  - Be willing to complete a pre-conference survey in preparation for the workshop
  - Be willing to complete a brief survey/testimonial following the conference about their experience
  - Provide letter of reference from a health care professional or advocate indicating their experience in patient advocacy (including research advocacy, public policy/legislative advocacy, and/or cancer patient support).
